June 27, 1927 - May 22, 2015

Patricia Ann Sims died Friday, May 22, 2015 at the age of 88.

She was born June 27, 1927, in Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania. Patricia was the daughter of Lucile Brady and Walter Herwald Hartman.

Patricia held a Bachelors degree from the University Of Pittsburgh, and a Master's Degree of Education from Indiana University. Patricia was a member of Zeta Tau Alpha, Deborah Circle, and the American Association of University Women.

Patricia was an involved leadership member of Collingwood Presbyterian Church of Toledo, Ohio, the couple raised both of their sons in the Presbyterian faith there. She met her dashing WWII veteran beau, a kind gentleman who was world-traveled while employed at Flint Hurley Hospital in Flint, Michigan.
