Patrick William Peter Jardin, 42, of Sylvania, Ohio, unexpectedly passed away on Friday, November 14th, 2025.

Born April 26, 1983, in Toledo, Ohio. Patrick was a loving and devoted father, son, brother, uncle and cherished friend to many. He was a graduate of St. Francis DeSales High School where he played soccer and ran cross country. He attended the University of Toledo and Lourdes College. Patrick was a successful small business owner of Jardin Pool Company for over 20 years. He could frequently be seen driving his red work truck, aptly named “The Red Dragon” around town. Patrick was beloved by his customers; many he had worked with from the inception of his company.

Patrick frequently enjoyed spending time with family at the Jardin family cottage on Devils Lake. Additionally, Patrick was a lover of history (with an extensive knowledge of the Civil War), enjoyed golfing, fishing, hunting, playing chess and spending time with family and friends.
