Richard H. Metzger, died Friday, December 11, 2020 at Ebeid Hospice in Sylvania. He was born in Toledo, Ohio on June 11, 1928 to Siegfried and Lina Metzger. Dick attended Western Military Academy in Alton, IL and received a Business Administration Degree from Ohio State University in 1949. He was President of S. Metzger Company which sold fresh produce to restaurants, groceries and institutions and President of The Metzger Company which processed foods and sold paper products and frozen foods to restaurants and institutions.

He was a member of Scottish Rite and the Shrine. He was President of the Downtown Toledo Hi-Twelve, which was at the time the world's largest Masonic Lunch Group (1970) with 500 members. Also, he was on the Advisory Board of the Conlon Center and active in CASA and SCORE. Dick was a Board Member of Farmer's Savings Bank of Northwood, Ohio, Mid-Am Bank and TAGRA.

Dick was preceded in death by his son, Richard Elliott Metzger and was a member of Temple Congregation Shomer Emunim.

Surviving are his wife, Marlene "Boots" Metzger, son, Robert G. Metzger, grandsons, Seth(Amanda) Metzger and Elliott (Kristin) Metzger, seven great grandchildren and sister, Marion (Joe) Ambus, Naples,FL.
