Richard T. Murnen, 79, of Toledo, passed away Thursday, November 12, 2009, at Ebeid Hospice at Flower Hospital. He was born December 8, 1929, in Toledo and was the son of Raymond and Kathryn Murnen. Dick was class president and a proud graduate of the 1947 Class at Central Catholic High School. He was also an alumni volunteer for many years at Central Catholic. Dick served honorably in the U.S. Army, in Germany, during the Korean War. He was a member of Christ the King Church, where he coached CYO basketball and track. Dick was also a member of the Knights of Columbus, Third Degree and the Central Catholic High School Athletic Hall of Fame. He enjoyed playing tennis and was an avid Notre Dame fan. Dick was vice-president and part owner of Mortgage Investors Corp for over 40 years. Survivors include his wife of 55 years, Ann M.
