Rino Fioritto, 90, of Toledo, OH, passed away peacefully in his sleep, on Friday, January 5, 2018, at his home of 60 years. He was born September 28, 1927, in Cavassa Nuovo, Italy and was the son of Oswald and Maria Fioritto.
