



## Robert John McCullough

August 14, 1939 - March 10, 2010

Robert John “Bob” McCullough passed away peacefully, at his home, on Wednesday, March 10, 2010, surrounded by his family. He was born Kittanning, PA, to Robert Fletcher and Helen Gertrude (Miller) McCullough. Bob lived in Toledo for 60 years, graduating from St. Francis Grade School and Central Catholic High School, in 1957. He served honorably in the U.S. Marine Corp, in the 1960's, during the Cuban Missile Crisis and continued in the Reserves for several years. Bob was a member of St. Stephen's Catholic Church and was a former member and lector at St. Agnes Catholic Church for many years. He worked at Graybar Electric, Westinghouse, Kiemle-Hankins and retired from McNaughton-McKay, in 2005. After retirement, Bob enjoyed golfing, going to the casinos (especially Windsor) and swimming at the Y.M.C.A. Survivors include his wife, Mary Jo “Joey” (Irwin) McCullough; sons, John, James (Denise) and Thomas (Shannon); daughter, Molly (Ty); grandchildren, Kaci, Dalton, Riley and Kada Dru. Also surviving is his sister, Beverly (Donald) Leonhardt, nieces and nephews. Bob was preceded in death by his parents.
