Theodore Kozlowski, 89, of Toledo, OH, passed away May 15, 2011, surrounded by his loving family. Born January 1, 1922 in Toledo, Ohio, he was the son of late Harry and Mary Ann (Domian) Kozlowski. Todd graduated from Woodward High School and went on to work for Henry J. Spieker Company, later retiring from the Toledo Board of Education.
