Walter W. Missler, 89, of Toledo, Ohio died Monday September 24, 2007 at Medical University of Ohio, surrounded by his loving family. He was born on December 4, 1917 in Glandorf, Ohio to Peter and Emma (Ellerbrock) Missler. Walt was a 1936 graduate of Central Catholic High School.
